Dr. Jay Kulbertis updated board members on State budget talks, energy performance grant, APA, labor negotiations and attorney talks.

Vicki Kirby shared results with board members on the end of year Dibels testing and M-Step testing.

Michelle Denkins discussed the Superintendent evaluation changes that were made due to State regulations.
